Most New Yorkers go about their daily business oblivious to the fact that right here in their beloved city thousands of women are enslaved in the sex trafficking business. The industries range from street prostitution to strip clubs, peep booth shows, massage parlors, bars, private apartments and escort services. RNYC is a non-profit organization that aims to provide safe housing and specialized legal, medical and employment services, as well as optional spiritual activities. RNYC plans to implement a residential pilot (safe house) in the winter of 2010 for women survivors of international sex trafficking. Providing a home for women escaping sex trafficking is the primary goal of the program because when women escape trafficking, they are immediately in need of safe housing.
